Course Selection	<p>Incoming exchange students can select courses across a range of subject areas and are not restricted to courses only in their major. It is possible for undergraduate exchange students to choose courses from postgraduate programs, and vice versa. Exchange students are able to change their choices after arrival at Beihang.</p> <p>Courses are taught only once a year, either in the spring semester or in the autumn semester. One credit at Beihang generally equals to 16 hours of lecture time, around 2 – 2.5 ECTS credits.</p> <p>Course catalogue: Visit undergraduate level, postgraduate level or check the attachments</p>

Language of Instruction	English, Chinese
Language Requirement	<p>Exchange students must have sufficient skills in the English language to follow classes (at least level B1).</p> <p>Students should pass the Chinese Proficiency Test (HSK) with a minimum score of 5 before they could be admitted to Chinese-taught courses.</p>
Chinese Language Courses	Yes. Application for such courses takes place on arrival.
Application Documents	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. <i>Application Form</i> 2. <i>Study Plan</i> 3. <i>Copy of Passport</i> 4. <i>Official Transcript</i> 5. <i>Curriculum Vitae</i> 6. <i>Recommendation List (completed by home university)</i> <p>Before the deadlines, the home university should send a recommendation list (xls. format) and a single PDF file containing the other application documents to international@buaa.edu.cn.</p>
Health Insurance	Compulsory. The cost is 400 RMB for 6 months, paid upon arrival.
On-campus Accommodation	<p>Double-occupancy bedroom with bathroom at the International Student Dormitory (Building 10, Da Yun Cun). There is no single-room option. The monthly rent is around 650 RMB.</p> <p>Unfortunately, we are not able to guarantee on-campus accommodation for Fall 2016, because of dormitory renovation. The University is currently working on a solution to help you find alternative accommodation either on or off campus. It is possible that you will have to rent a room by yourselves. In that case, we will offer you sufficient guidance. Please kindly wait for an answer from us in June.</p>
Visa Requirements	Beihang University will send an Acceptance Letter along with the JW201/JW202 form for each student which is necessary for visa application.
Transcript	The transcript of record will be available in the first month of the next semester and will be posted to coordinators at our partner universities.
